PLATFORM MAINTENANCE

As you may know, American High School has been working on the development of a new LMS (Learning Management System/platform) which has some really great features and tools incorporated.

In preparation for the new LMS and the existing LMS to co-exist for a short period until all students are moved over to the new LMS with all the latest and greatest functionality American High School will bring the servers down (close access) at 23.00 hours Spanish time on Friday 8th February - so that everyone in Spain can work until 11 pm if necessary and they will bring them back up (open access) on Monday 11th February at 06.00 hours Spanish time.

If students take screen shots of assessments or E-books before Friday they can still do their activity blocks at the weekend, they just will not be able to submit their work until Monday.

- 1 Read the comments/feedback from your American teachers in your gradebooks and in the messages they send to you on your platform and apply their recommendations to the next assessments that you submit
- **2** Complete your journal activities always and submit them in the correct place on your platform before attempting to do the assessments of that lesson/unit as you will obtain better grades like that.


